Bro. Mickey,

Just wanted you to know how much of a blessing that you and your wife have been to my wife and I. This past year and a half has been one of the hardest years I have spent in my 50 years of ministry. Having half the church walk out because of racial bias and other things really struck a blow to our church and me personally. A long story made short, I had invited a white preacher with a black wife to preach for me. This became a catalyst to an underlying problem and eventuated the walkout.

In the months following I have faced just about every emotional agony imaginable and I know most of it is imagination. The decision I made was the right one scripturally and honestly. My age and tenure here of 26 years has caused aggravation with at least one request that I resign. In a small town of 6000 with 7 Baptist churches and ours being the only fundamental independent one it is necessary that we continue. I know beyond doubt that the Lord wants me to stay here until we can recover from the attack of satan. There is still a good nucleus of people who want to continue.

This is where you folks come in. The fact that you show a genuine interest in our burden and have provided ideas and counsel has been used of the Lord to encourage us. Without any sign of overwhelming our structure, you have walked along side and offered your expertise. I appreciate that very much.

I have been in the Lord's service since 1956 and know that satan has several methods of attack on churches. Your desire to learn his methods and how to counteract them is a needed ministry and is a great help when (not if) those attacks come.
